

## How To Register for Music For Everyone

### Private Lessons:

1. Choose the instrument you wish to study
2. Contact Anna Shmidov, Music For Everyone Coordinator, to be matched with an instructor.
3. Register for lessons in the city where lessons will take place.
4. Bring your receipt to the first lessons as confirmation of payment.

### Group Classes:

You may register directly for group classes in the city where the class will take place.

### Resident Status:

Residents of Brooklyn Park, Golden Valley, Maple Grove, New Hope, and Plymouth receive resident status in the Music For Everyone Program. People living outside of the member cities are welcome to register for all lessons and group classes, but will be charged a small non-resident fee.

### **PIANO**

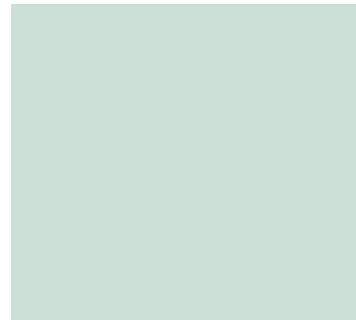
