**CALL TO ORDER**

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, the City Council of the city of New Hope met as the Canvassing Board at the New Hope City Hall on Monday, November 8, 2010, at 6:45 p.m.

**ELECTION RESULTS**  
**Item 11.1**

Mayor Hemken introduced for discussion, Item 11.1, Resolution certifying results of the City Council election of November 2, 2010.

Ms. Valerie Leone, city clerk, distributed the official results summary of the City Council election of November 2, 2010, and explained that overall voter turnout was 60%. The following results were reviewed:

Council Member (four year term) – two seats

John A. Elder	3,436
Daniel W. Stauner	2,068
William L. Smith	1,849
Wayne E. Detzler	1,582

Congratulations were extended to Council Members Elder and Stauner on their re-election.

Council Member Elder questioned the technical difficulties at Hennepin County and inquired whether that issue had any effect on the city council vote totals. City Clerk Leone confirmed the accuracy of the ballot counts.

City Manager Kirk McDonald noted New Hope was not selected for the 2010 post election review. City Clerk Leone explained that 13 out of 400+ county-wide precincts are randomly drawn for a post audit review. She stated New Hope participated in 2006 and no abnormalities were detected. It was noted that the city's voted ballots will be stored at the government center and included in the governor's race recount.

Council conveyed its appreciation to city staff and the election judges for their part in the election process.

**RESOLUTION 10-152**  
**Item 11.1**

Council Member Elder introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption: **"RESOLUTION CERTIFYING RESULTS OF THE CITY COUNCIL ELECTION OF NOVEMBER 2, 2010"**. The motion for the adoption of the foregoing resolution was seconded by Council Member Stauner, and upon vote being taken thereon, the following voted in favor thereof: Hemken, Elder, Lammle, Stauner, and the following voted against the same: None; Abstained: None; Absent: Hoffe; whereupon the resolution was declared duly passed and adopted, signed by the mayor which was attested to by the city clerk.

**ADJOURNMENT**

Motion was made by Council Member Lammle, seconded by Council Member Stauner, **to adjourn the meeting as there was no further business to come before the Canvassing Board**. All voted in favor. The Canvassing Board adjourned at 6:54 p.m.
