### **New Hope Council makes several appointments**

The New Hope City Council appointed new members to the Human Rights Commission and West Metro Fire-Rescue District Board of Directors and reappointed representatives to several city commissions.

Tanner Berris, a sophomore at Armstrong High School was named a student commissioner on the New Hope Human Rights Commission. The commission still has an opening available for a second student member. Student commissioners serve for an academic school year. Council member John Elder was appointed to a two year term on the West Metro fire board. He replaces resident Brian Hubbard who served for two terms on the board and did not seek reappointment.

Marie Hayes and Otis Jenkins were reappointed to two year terms on the New Hope Human Rights Commission. Susan Wallace and Ginger Sisco were reappointed to two year terms as New Hope's representatives on the Northwest Hennepin Human Services Council. Paul Anderson was reappointed to a three year term on the New Hope Planning Commission. And, Jonathan London, Rick Riley and Mike Terres were all reappointed to two year terms on the New Hope Citizen Advisory Commission (CAC). Ken Pronovici, who served on the CAC for four years, did not seek reappointment.
