ORDINANCE NO. 2023-07

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 8-29 TATTOO AND BODY PIERCING ESTABLISHMENTS ORDINANCE IN THE NEW HOPE CITY CODE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW HOPE ORDAINS:

Section 1. Section 8-29 (c)(4) – Tattoo and body piercing establishments is hereby amended to repeal the stricken text and add the following underlined text:

- (c) *License application.*
 - (2) If the applicant is a partnership:
 - a. The name(s) and address(es) of all general and limited partners and all information concerning each general partner required in subsection (c)(1) a of thise section.
 - (3) If the applicant is a corporation or other business:
 - c. The name of the stockholder(s), manager(s), proprietor(s), or other agent(s) in charge of the business and all information concerning each stockholder, manager, proprietor, or agent required in subsection (c)(1) a of this section.
 - (4) For all applicants:
 - a. Whether the applicant holds a <u>valid state-issued</u> <u>eurrent</u> tattooing or body piercing license <u>or a valid dual body art technician license if the applicant</u> performs both tattooing and body piercing pursuant to Minn. Stat. §146B.03 <u>for any other governmental unit.</u>
 - d. Whenever the application is for premises either planned or under construction or undergoing substantial-<u>alterations</u> alternations, the application shall be accompanied by a set of preliminary plans showing the design of the proposed premises to be licensed. If the plans of design are on file with the city building official, no plans need be submitted.
- (i) General license requirements.
 - (7) Liability insurance. All licensees shall have at all times a valid certificate of insurance issued by an insurance company licensed to do business in the state indicating that the licensee is currently covered in the tattoo business by a liability insurance policy. The minimum limits of coverage for such insurance shall be:
